READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

The adopter agrees to the following conditions of the contract.

- 1) To provide quality food, water, and shelter at all times.
 - a.) They will be kept indoors, in suitable housing, large enough for the animal to get exercise required when they are unable to be left out. ie: while you are at work.
- 2) To provide proper medical care-from a **knowledgeable** ferret vet including vaccinations, to keep the ferret in good health.
- 3) The Shelter that has relinquished said ferret has the right to visit and inspect the adopted household.
- 4) I agree to abide by all local animal ordinances, and anti-cruelty laws.
- 5) I am adopting this ferret as a household pet, and companion for myself, not for anyone else.
- 6) **I WILL NOT SELL, OR GIVE THE FERRET AWAY. IF I CAN NO LONGER KEEP IT I WILL RETURN IT TO THE LAKEROAD FERRET FARM RESCUE/SHELTER ONLY.**
- 7) If I am unable to spend quality time with the ferret(s), unable to keep them as pets, abuse or mistreat the ferrets(s) or have to give them up for any reason I will contact the Lakeroad Ferret Farm Rescue/Shelter to be returned.
 - a) A full refund of the adoption donation is only guaranteed up to 7 days after the adoption.
- 8) I will contact the L.R.F.F. if I have any problems with the ferret(s) we will determine together if the problem can be worked out.
- 9) I agree not to let the ferret(s) outside unattended or unsupervised
- 10) I agree to notify L.R.F.F. immediately should the ferret become lost.
- 11) I agree to notify L.R.F.F. of the death, (and cause thereof of this ferret).

IMPORTANT NOTICE

While The Lakeroad Ferret Farm Rescue/Shelter makes every effort to place only healthy animals, we cannot guarantee the extended health of any animal adopted from our shelter, or can we be responsible for any medical expenses which may be incurred by the ferret.

The Lakeroad Ferret Farm limits its warranties to a 7-day refund.

Any other expenses including medical treatment, if needed are the responsibility of the adopter.

Once the ferret is adopted L.R.F.F. is not responsible, or liable for any damages or injuries caused by the adopted animal. Adopters take full responsibility and will hold The Lakeroad Ferret Farm harmless in all matters.

ADOPTION DONATION

I (WE) THE ADOPTER UNDERSTAND THAT THE ADOPTION DONATION IS TO HELP THE SHELTER DEFRAY THE EXPENSE OF CARING FOR THIS AND OTHER ANIMALS. THE DONATION IS NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER THE SEVEN-DAY (7) GRACE PERIOD EVEN IF THE ANIMAL IS RETURNED. THE ADOPTION DONATION INCLUDES THE INITIAL VETERINARY CHECK-UP SPAYING/NEUTERING, AND FIRST DISTEMP/ER/RABIES VACCINATION.

It is agreed that The Lakeroad Ferret Farm Rescue/Shelter retains superior title to said animal, limited to and for, the express purpose of assuring the animals' well being. The L.R.F.F. will only exercise its superior claim in the event it appears to L.R.F.F. that the proper humane care, as specified in the previously stated adoption provisions, is not being afforded said animal. In which case the animal may be taken through a claim and delivery proceeding. In the event legal action is necessary because of a violation of the adoption agreement, and expenses and/or court costs and attorneys fees are incurred, the adopter agrees to pay those costs occasioned by The Lakeroad Ferret Farm Rescue/Shelter.

A 7-day grace period is allowed to determine compatibility and/or health of the adopted ferret. After this time NO refunds will be made.
